


White Label App Documentation

It takes large amount of investment to develop an app on your website for your customers to book rides in 100+ countries and regions with extensive vehicle selections from sedan to coach bus. Elife's white label kit enables partners to quickly drop Elife's leading ride booking widget in their websites with minimal development and to start earning commission on those rides.

Steps to Run the application

- 1. Please download the zip folder called white-label-app.zip into your local folder. Inside this zip folder there are three files: index.html, logo.png and style.css. This is all you need.
- 2. In order to run the application, please open the index.html on computer with your browser. The Elife ride booking page will be displayed in the browser as follows and you can book as if you are on Elife's home page.




Note: please make sure all three files (index.html, logo.png and style.css) exist in the same folder. If one of the files is missing on misplaced into another folder page may not function as intended.




- 3. To test how it works
 - a. Put an input value in the ride form (Pick up location, Drop off location, Date/Time) and click on "Choose Vehicle"

Example:




b. New page will be rendered to with a list of cars.






c. Please choose a car of your choice and click on "Select" to proceed to the next page. A form with a contact information will appear. Provide a value for those field and Click "Pay" button.



Note: Please fill out all required fields.

d. Then finally a stripe page for payment will be rendered here as follows:



You will see ride id and service fee to be paid to page on the left top corner. This ride id will indicate to that your ride is ready to me create.

Even though the index file is local on your computer and the web address on your browser shows the local, you are connected to Elife's production booking widget and API. If you make payment for the ride, Elife will deliver the service.



How to configure/customized white label app

Configuration

Part of this app are open for customization and/or configuration. In order to configure the app please contact us (To business development team at Elife) to get *Affiliate ID and Affiliate Name*, which is allocated to you.

After getting the affiliate id and name please open the index.html in an editor like visual studio code or notepad++ or another editor too. Scroll down or searches where affiliate_id and affiliate_name then change them with the new given name.

'affiliate_id=<<given id>>&affiliate_name=<<given name>>'

How to change logo

To change logo please replace the "logo.png" file with your own logo with the same name as before. Then open the "index.html" file in the editor and search for *src="logo.png"*

Adjust the width and height of the logo here.

Note: if you have a logo hosted on the web you can also place the address of the logo inside the src as:

Integration with your website

To integrate the white label kit with website please create a folder called

"book-a-ride" inside your website source folder and put customized white

label kit files (the three files) in the "book-a-ride" folder. "Book-a-ride" is just

an example; you are free to choose whatever examples you want.

Then create a URL path pointing to "book-a-ride/index.html". For example, if

your website's address is "xyz.com/" you can add an URL path as

"xyz.com/book-a-ride" then when your user goes to the URL, they will see

the white label page and book an ELife ride while the URL is still

"xyz.com/book-a-ride".

rides.
